





CULTURAL SPOTLIGHT

Africa is famous for its incredible wildlife, but there's also a vibrant culture to be found in every region we visit. From the warrior tribes in Kenya's Maasai Mara to the Intore dancers in Rwanda and the unwavering traditions of the Himba people in Namibia, there's a lot to discover!

Along with animals, our itineraries put an emphasis on experiencing cultures, interacting with the locals and visiting rural villages because we believe this helps to benefit the communities and really capture the essence of the places we visit.













LEVEL OF FITNESS

To get the most from your Bunnik Tour you will need a good level of fitness and mobility and an open mind. Travelling through Africa is mainly done by road. A high percentage of roads are not sealed and most tracks within national parks are dirt roads. Some travel days are also very long. Per tour, you will find a list of the different vehicle types used. Most excursions are by 4WD so if you suffer from a back condition we highly recommend that you consult your doctor before booking. If you wear contact lenses we recommend bringing glasses as well, in case of irritation caused by dust.

You should be able to: walk at least 3.5km or 2-3 hours on uneven ground, without a walking aid; climb short, steep hills; be prepared to board small boats; and also carry your own bags as porter services may not always be available.

- In Uganda the trek to the mountain gorillas can last up to 6 hours, and in Rwanda the trek is approximately 2 hours.
- In Madagascar your touring includes half- and full-day hikes.
- In Ethiopia the trekking in the Simien Mountains National Park is done at high altitude.

Passengers who are 70 and over will be required to obtain a doctor's clearance before travelling.

LUGGAGE RESTRICTIONS

Given the limited storage space in light aircraft and safari vehicles, for travel within Africa a **soft bag is required**.

For the following tours, there is also a **maximum weight of 15kg** per person:

- South Africa, Botswana & Kenya
- Kenya & Tanzania
- Tanzania & Rwanda
- Cairo to Zanzibar
- Morocco & Kenya






RESPONSIBLE TOURISM

Bunnik Tours firmly believes that tourism can create understanding between cultures and generate economic and social benefits in the places we visit.

Our small groups are low-impact and don't ruin the very places we go to see.

In Africa we only use professionally accredited guides and expert trackers trained in animal behaviour and protection. Guides undergo rigorous training in ethics and procedures to ensure minimal impact on the environment and the wildlife. They are also required to report any unusual activities.

We only visit national parks and private concessions where animals roam freely in their natural habitat, and we strictly adhere to rules designed to protect the natural environment and prevent human/wildlife conflict.



PERMITS INCLUDED



We don't like added extras, so our tour and independent and extension package prices include entrance to all national parks and reserves. We've also covered the permits for gorilla trekking and chimpanzee habituation, as well as golden monkey and Angola colobus monkey tracking. To give you an idea, a gorilla tracking permits costs approximately US \$1,500 and a chimpanzee permit around US \$250.







A DAY ON SAFARI

Safari is the quintessential African experience. Whether you're spotting lions in the Maasai Mara, watching elephants drink at a waterhole in Chobe National Park, or tracking wildebeest in the Ngorongoro Crater - every day is a new adventure.



O An Early Start

We wake up with the sun to beat the heat of the day and witness the wildlife and landscapes bathed in the beautiful morning glow.

Dressed in light, layered clothing and sturdy shoes, and after a quick coffee or tea, we board our safari vehicle. The mornings can still be quite cold so we suggest you also bring a scarf and beanie.

Our safari vehicles are normally 7- or 9-person 4WDs so everyone gets close to the action. For touring in east Africa, our 4WDs travel with only 6 people in each - meaning everyone gets a window seat. In some of the national parks our vehicles are opentop, and in others we're enclosed for protection.

Have your camera and binoculars ready. Our driver and guide are experts and will find the best spots to see a myriad of local wildlife over the next few hours.

Relax & Recharge


After an exciting morning we'll return to the lodge for breakfast. Then it's time to relax, lounge by the pool with a book or explore the grounds.

There's some more time at leisure after lunch (you might want to catch up on sleep after our early morning start).

Evening Excitement

As the sun begins to set, we prepare for our second game drive of the day. Board the safari vehicle for another incredible game drive, this time to capture magnificent wildlife and scenery in the golden hour.

It wouldn't be a trip to Africa without sundowners overlooking the vast savannahs. We'll then return to our lodge and prepare for dinner and an evening under the stars.








IMBALI SAFARI LODGE SOUTH AFRICA







SPECIAL EXPERIENCES





You will also need to arrange travel insurance. Unfortunately this is not a choice, it's compulsory as we'd hate for something to happen and you not be covered.

Payment Schedules

About 4-8 weeks after your booking has been confirmed, we'll request a progress

payment in order to cover airfares, taxes and fuel surcharges. The progress payment for Africa is \$3,000 per person. This amount increases if you are flying premium, business or first class.

This payment allows us to issue your flight tickets and ensures you don't get hit with airline increases on fuel surcharges and taxes

Your final balance is due 60 to 90 days before you depart, depending on the tour you have booked. You'll find our cancellation policy and other terms and conditions in the back of this brochure.

Passports and Visas

Australian travellers require visas for a number of countries. We can help you

obtain them. It's important to note that they can take time to arrange, so early booking is recommended.

We will also require a photocopy of your passport which must be valid for travel for at least six months from the date you are planning to return to Australia.

Your Travel Documents

Your documents, including itineraries and hotel lists, are prepared approximately three weeks before you depart. If you require your documentation earlier than this, please be sure to let us know.



Day 2. Arrive Windhoek


Welcome to diverse Namibia! Enjoy a group welcome dinner this evening. [D]

Day 5. Sossusvlei

An incredible day! As the sun rises we'll travel to the highest dunes on earth at Sossusvlei and Dead Vlei, and visit Sesriem Canyon. We'll then take an evening sundowner drive to view the local flora and fauna and enjoy a spectacular sunset. [B,D]

Day 6. Sossusvlei - Swakopmund

If you do not comply with the above we can withdraw you from the tour and at your own expense you must make other arrangements and we are not liable for any loss, cost or damage you may suffer or incur.

RISK AND LIABILITY

While your safety is of paramount concern, it is acknowledged by all parties that there are general risks involved with travelling that are beyond our control. We are not liable to you for any loss, cost or damage you may incur as a result of these general risks which include contact with native fauna, local residents, unforeseen events and travel in remote locations.

By making this booking you agree that there are associated risks and you release us unconditionally from all liability including and not limited to:

- · Any cause of action including injury, damage, loss, cost, delay, additional expenses, inconvenience caused directly or indirectly as a result of the inherent risks associated with the tour,
- · Any force majeure events or other events beyond our control including but not limited to war, civil disobedience, terrorism, insurrection, accidents, explosion, sickness, fire, floods, severe weather, acts of God, acts of Government, alteration or cancellation of scheduled air services, accidents to or failure of machinery or equipment or industrial action. If we or our service providers are affected in any way by a force majeure event, it is our discretion to either vary or cancel any itinerary or arrangement in relation the tour as we consider necessary without, incurring any liability to you.

Each service provider is responsible for the part of the tour it conducts. Service providers are not our agents or employees and are not under our direct control. We therefore do not warrant the performance or service of any service provider. Without limitation, you release us from all liability and any claim you may have in relation to the service provider should be raised with them directly. Regardless whether the act arises with omission from the service provider including:

- Personal injury
- Loss
- Damage
- Costs & Expenses
- Property Damage

It is your responsibility to take care and diligence while on tour and you indemnify us against all actions, proceedings, claims, demands, expenses and costs (inclusive of legal costs on a full indemnity basis and whether incurred by or awarded or against us) as a result of, or arising directly or indirectly to being on tour or any act or omission by you in relation to the tour and no refund will be provided of any unused portion of the tour.

In the event of any force majeure events, we or the service provider will undertake to make other arrangements to continue the tour in a manner that can be best arranged. You acknowledge that a force majeure event may result in a cancellation of any proposed or planned tours or continuation of the proposed tour. If travel is not possible due to flooding, arrangements will be attempted to be made to continue the tour as best as can be arranged, by other means such as bus or rail. It is also acknowledged by you that the tour may not be able to be provided as advertised and we will use our best endeavours to make alternative arrangements regarding itinerary, travel and accommodation.

HEALTH AND FITNESS

A minimum level of fitness is required to be able to participate on a Bunnik Tour, you are required to at least:

- Be able to walk 3.5kms or 2-3 hours on uneven surfaces without the use of any walking aid
- · Carry your own luggage
- Climb short, steep hills

Passengers 70 years or over must provide "fitness to travel" letter from their doctor at time of making

Passengers must inform us and the service provider of any medical conditions which may affect your ability to participate in the tour.

At our discretion we, including the service provider, can exclude you in a tour or in any activity if we consider that you are unable to safely participate in that tour or activity or if we consider your participation may place the safety of other guests at risk.

We exclude all liability for any illness, injury or death sustained by you on tour because of any pre-existing medical condition. You release us from all liability arising out of your medical condition, illness, or injury that you may suffer during the tour or as a result of the tour.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

While travel insurance is not inclusive in the tour fee, it is mandatory for all our clients travelling on a Bunnik Tour to obtain comprehensive travel insurance to cover you throughout the whole duration of the tour to cover costs associated with illness, injury, death, loss of or damage to baggage and personal items, cancellations, loss of deposit, medical and hospitalization expenses, repatriation and curtailments expenses due to illness, the need to return home unexpectedly, evacuation expenses, and accidental death or disability. This should be taken out at time of booking.

It is your responsibility to obtain comprehensive travel insurance, however please note that travel insurance offered by credit card companies may not be considered adequate cover.

AMENDMENT FEES


