DAY 1 ARRIVE IN BERLIN, GERMANY. (Fri.)

Welcome to Berlin! At 6 pm, meet your Tour Director and travelling companions, and begin your fellowship at this evening's welcome dinner at your hotel. (D)

DAY 2 BERLIN-WITTENBERG. (Sat.)

Sightseeing with a Local Guide in the once-divided metropolis includes the elegant Ku'damm, the restored Reichstag, Charlottenburg Castle, a picture stop at monumental Brandenburg Gate, the Holocaust Memorial, and the 21-foot Victory Column. Visit the KAISER WILHELM MEMORIAL CHURCH, a memorial to peace and reconciliation. Drive along Unter den Linden boulevard, and pass the State Opera House and Checkpoint Charlie, the best known former border between east and west Berlin. In the afternoon, continue to Wittenberg, Martin Luther's hometown for more than 30 years and birthplace of the Reformation. (B,D)

DAY 3 WITTENBERG-LEIPZIG. (Sun.)

Enjoy a guided walking tour of Wittenberg and visit the LUTHER HOUSE, where Martin Luther and his family lived. Also visit ST. MARY'S CHURCH, a twin-towered gothic church where Luther preached reform, got married, and baptised his six children. Finally, see the door of Castle Church, where Luther posted his 95 Theses, launching the Reformation in 1517. Continue to Leipzig for a walking tour and a visit to THOMASKIRCHE, where Johann Sebastian Bach worked as a cantor. Also, see the market square that today is a site for celebrations and festivals, but once was the scene of executions and political demonstrations. (B,D)

Today's Distance: 68 mi / 110 km

DAY 4 LEIPZIG-EISLEBEN-ERFURT. (Mon.)

Today, stop in Eisleben, and visit Luther's BIRTH HOUSE and DEATH HOUSE MUSEUMS, as well as ST. PETER & PAUL CHURCH, where Luther was baptised, and ST, ANDREW'S CHURCH, where Luther preached his last sermon in 1546. Continue to Erfurt, whose 36 churches, 15 monasteries, and other ecclesiastical buildings have earned it the nickname "Thuringian Rome." The beautiful Old Town preserves the atmosphere Luther must have experienced during his student days. A highlight is an inspirational visit to the AUGUSTINIAN MONASTERY where Luther lived as a monk in his youth, and the unique MERCHANTS' BRIDGE, lined with half-timbered homes on both sides. (B)

Todav's Distance: 127 mi / 205 km

DAY 5 ERFURT. EXCURSION TO EISENACH. (Tue.)

Journey to Eisenach and meet your Local Guide. Visit LUTHER HOUSE. ST. GEORGE'S CHURCH, where Luther was a choir boy and later preached, and see the Luther and Bach Memorials. Also, visit beautifully restored WARTBURG CASTLE, where he lived in disguise as "Knight George." It was during this period that Luther translated the New Testament from Ancient Greek into German in just ten weeks. (B,D) Today's Distance: 99 mi / 160 km

DAY 6 ERFURT-COBURG-WIESBADEN. (Wed.)

Continue south today to Coburg and visit fascinating COBURG FORTRESS, where Luther lived protected during the Imperial Diet of Augsburg in 1530. As an outlaw of the Holy Roman Empire, he could not attend the Imperial Diet of Augsburg, but instead spent his time continuing his work translating the *Bible* and writing on Reformation issues. (B,D) Today's Distance: 255 mi / 410 km

DAY 7 WIESBADEN. EXCURSION TO THE RHINE VALLEY, WORMS & MAINZ. (Thu.)

Enjoy a scenic RHINE CRUISE past castle-crested cliffs, terraced vineyards, and half-timbered towns. In Worms, where the Imperial Council passed judgment on Luther in 1521, visit the CATHEDRAL where Luther presented his case, as well as TRINITY CHURCH and the Reformation monument. Continue to Mainz to visit the GUTENBERG MUSEUM, which houses original copies of the Bible. (B)

Today's Distance: 162 mi / 260 km

DAY 8 WIESBADEN-ROTHENBURG-NUREMBERG. (Fri.)

Journey to the medieval walled town of Rothenburg, where your walking tour takes you to ST. JACOB'S CHURCH with its masterpiece Altar of the Holy Blood. Afterwards, there is time to shop for the town's famed Christmas ornaments. On to Nuremberg, the first town to accept the Reformation in 1525. Your walking tour features the gothic ST. LORENZ LUTHERAN CHURCH, where you can pause for quiet meditation. (B,D)

DAY 9 NUREMBERG-GARMISCH-PARTENKIRCHEN. (Sat.)

Continue to picturesque Garmisch-Partenkirchen. (B,D)

In Munich, explore Germany's "Secret Capital" with your local guide, including the Olympic Stadium, the 1,000-foot-high Television Tower, MARIENPLATZ with the Old and the New Town Halls, and the gothic Frauenkirche. DAY 1 ARRIVE IN ATHENS, GREECE. (Sun.)

Welcome to Athens! At 6 pm, meet your Tour Director and travelling companions, then enjoy a welcome dinner at your hotel to celebrate the start of your upcoming spiritual journey. (D)

DAY 2 ATHENS-THESSALONIKA. (Mon.)

Head north to Thessalonika this morning for guided sightseeing. Named after Alexander the Great's sister, it figures prominently in the New Testament. This city was the centre of Apostle Paul's activities in northern Greece—where he preached, founded a church, and to whom he wrote his two *Thessalonian* epistles. St. Paul, whose name was originally Saul, was a Roman citizen and a Pharisee. He experienced a powerful vision that caused him to convert to Christianity while on the road to Damascus, and he was baptised with the name of Paul. He then started travelling through Macedonia, Greece, Italy, the Holy Land, and Spain to spread the Word and led a very adventurous life. Paul wrote a series of letters, known as the epistles, that are an integral part of the New Testament giving advice on how Christians should live. He died in Rome, beheaded by order of Emperor Nero, in 67 AD. (B,D)

Todav's Distance: 314 mi / 503 km

DAY 3 THESSALONIKA, EXCURSION TO PHILIPPI & KAVALA, (Tue.)

Today begins along Paul's route via Amphipolis, a wealthy city in ancient Macedonia, where a large number of Christian churches were built in the 5th and 6th centuries. Next, travel to Philippi, a busy Roman colony with an impressive library and theatre. It was here that Paul preached and established the first church in Europe, and to whom he wrote his *Philippians* epistle while imprisoned in Rome, in which he expressed great fondness for that community. Continue to Kavala, ancient port of Neapolis. (B,D)

Today's Distance: 219 mi / 350 km

DAY 4 THESSALONIKA-VERIA-KALAMBAKA. (Wed.)

This morning, stop in Veria (called Berea in the New Testament), where Paul and Silas were sent by friends after being accused of treason in Thessalonika. Visit the BEMA OF APOSTLE PAUL, where he preached the gospel to the local community, then continue to Kalambaka, home to the awe-inspiring Meteora monasteries. (B,D)

Today's Distance: 137 mi / 220 km

DAY 5 KALAMBAKA-METEORA-ATHENS. (Thu.)

A real highlight is in store today. Situated atop soaring cliffs and rock faces, the Meteora monasteries create one of the most inspirational sites in the world. Visit the HOLY MONASTERY OF VARLAAM, the second-largest of the monasteries, and the HOLY MONASTERY OF ST. STEPHEN, which was bombed by the Nazis during WWII but later was reconstructed by nuns. Here, you will be introduced to the many historical and religious treasures. Return to Athens for an overnight. (B)

Today's Distance: 230 mi / 370 km

DAY 6 ATHENS-PIRAEUS (EMBARKATION)-MYKONOS. (Fri.)

Awaken refreshed this morning and ready to begin your 3-night CRUISE around the Greek Isles and Turkey. Head first to mountainous Mykonos with its iconic windmills and brilliant whitewashed houses. Wander through the narrow winding streets, do a little shopping, or sit in a café to people watch. (B,L,D)

DAY 7 CRUISING: KUSADASI, TURKEY-EXCURSION TO EPHESUS-PATMOS, GREECE, (Sat.)

Visit the Turkish port of Kusadasi for an included excursion to the EPHESUS ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITE, the former capital of the Roman province of Asia. Walk in the footsteps of Apostle Paul, who lived and preached here, and meditate on what life must have been like for the early Ephesian Christians in this pagan society. Continue your cruise to the island of Patmos, the "Jerusalem of the Aegean," where you can join an optional excursion to see the Monastery of St. John and the Cave of the Apocalypse. Here, John the Evangelist received the visions that he recorded in the Book of the Revelation during his exile. (B,L,D)

DAY 8 CRUISING: HERAKLION, CRETE-SANTORINI. (Sun.)

First port of call today is Heraklion on Crete. Enjoy an excursion to nearby KNOSSOS, the centre of the 3000 BC Minoan civilisation and historic site of mythology's tales about the *Minotaur* and the labyrinth. Afternoon call (weather permitting) at Santorini, the "Black Pearl of the Aegean." An optional excursion, that will take you to the cliff-top village of Oia for one of the world's most glorious panoramic views, is available, (B.L.D)

Amphipolis



DAY 1 ARRIVE IN TEL AVIV, ISRAEL. (Mon.)

Welcome to Tel Aviv. Enjoy this evening's welcome dinner, hosted by your Tour Director, who will introduce you to your upcoming spiritual journey. (D)

DAY 2 TEL AVIV-JAFFA-CAESAREA-MEGIDDO-MUHRAQA-SEA OF GALILEE. (Tue.)

Your tour of the Holy Land begins in Jaffa with a walk through the beautifully restored ANCIENT PORT, where medieval pilgrims started their strenuous 2-day trek to Jerusalem. Next is Caesarea, the perfect place to learn about the Roman and Crusader presence in the country. Visit the archaeological site with the ROMAN AMPHITHEATRE and the impressive medieval CRUSADER FORTRESS, and admire Herod's Stadium and harbour. In the afternoon, travel to the ancient fortified city of MEGIDDOone of the world's most important biblical sites. According to the New Testament, the Battle of Armageddon (another name for Megiddo) will be the final struggle between good and evil, prompting the return of Jesus to defeat the Antichrist and cast Satan into the abyss. Continue north, to Mount Carmel, considered the most holy of all mountains in ancient times. At Muhraqa, site of Elijah's contest of faith with the priests of Baal, enjoy a sweeping panoramic view of the fertile Jezreel Valley, where Gideon led the Israelites to victory against the Midianites. Arrive at your hotel in Tiberias on the western shore of the Sea of Galilee. (B,D) Today's Distance: 99 mi / 160 km

DAY 3 SEA OF GALILEE. EXCURSION TO CANA & NAZARETH. (Wed.) Visit CANA, site of Jesus' wedding miracle of turning water into wine. Even now, many couples renew their wedding vows at this sacred place. On to

Nazareth, Virgin Mary's home village, and where Jesus spent part of his childhood. Visit the CHURCH OF THE ANNUNCIATION; ST. JOSEPH'S CHURCH, built over Joseph's carpentry workshop; and pass by Mary's Well and the Church of the Angel Gabriel, where the angel appeared to Mary to announce she would give birth to Jesus. Later enjoy a CRUISE on the Sea of Galilee and see an ancient fishing boat, said to be from the time of Christ. (B,D) Todav's Distance: 39 mi / 62 km

DAY 4 SEA OF GALILEE-MOUNT OF BEATITUDES-TABGHA-CAPERNAUM-MAGDALA-JORDAN RIVER-BET SHE'AN-JERUSALEM. (Thu.)

Much of Jesus' ministry occurred on the shores surrounding the Sea of Galilee. It is where he recruited four of his apostles, walked on water, calmed the storm, and fed the multitude. Visit the MOUNT OF BEATITUDES, where Jesus delivered his Sermon on the Mount, Next, visit the CHURCH OF THE MULTIPLICATION OF LOAVES AND FISHES at Tabgha, as well as the CHURCH OF ST. PETER'S PRIMACY, where Jesus instructed Peter "to feed my lambs and tend my sheep." Warm springs once flowed into the sea here, attracting fish, which is why Peter came here to earn a living. On to CAPERNAUM, where Jesus recruited his first followers among the fishermen. Continue to MAGDALA, a city dating back to the first century and where Jesus taught in the synagogue. Via the ruins of Kursi, which memorialise two of Jesus' miracles, arrive at the Jordan River and visit a BAPTISMAL SITE. Then, pass through the ancient city of Bet She'an, one of the cities of the Decapolis with its well-preserved Roman amphitheatre. The city is located at the foot of Mount Gilboa, where King Saul and his son died by their own hands in battle with the Philistines. On the way to Jerusalem, stop for a breathtaking panoramic view of the Holy City, considered one of the oldest places in the world, with a history dating back as far as 4000 BC. (B,D)

DAY 5 JERUSALEM. EXCURSION TO EIN KAREM, BETHLEHEM & THE GARDEN TOMB. (Fri.)

Today's Distance: 134 mi / 216 km

This morning, drive to Ein Karem and visit the CHURCH OF ST. JOHN THE BAPTIST and the CHURCH OF VISITATION, said to be built over the home of John the Baptist's parents. Enjoy a beautiful view of the valley and surrounding wooded hills. Continue to Bethlehem and see Shepherd's Field, where the angels announced the birth of Jesus. Next, visit the CHURCH OF THE NATIVITY on the site where Jesus was born. On the way back to Jerusalem, visit the GARDEN TOMB. (B,D) Today's Distance: 34 mi / 55 km







DAY 6 JERUSALEM. EXCURSION TO THE OLD CITY. (Sat.)

After a stunning view of the city from the revered MOUNT OF OLIVES, start your guided walking tour. Via the Chapel of Dominus Flevit, designed in the shape of a teardrop to symbolise the tears of Christ, arrive at the GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE, where Jesus prayed the night before his arrest. Nearby are the Cave of the Assumption of Mary, believed to be the Virgin Mary's tomb; and the Cave of Betrayal, where Judas betrayed Jesus. Follow the VIA DOLOROSA with its nine Stations of the Cross, marking the path Jesus walked on the way to his crucifixion. At Golgotha, visit the CHURCH OF THE HOLY SEPULCHRE, erected on the site of the crucifixion and which houses the remaining five Stations of the Cross. Walk past the Temple Mount to see the Dome of the Rock, which is sacred to both the Jewish and Muslim people. On to the WESTERN WALL, the only remnant of the Second Temple, then stroll through the restored Jewish Quarter to MOUNT ZION and visit the UPPER ROOM, where Jesus and his disciples had the Last Supper; the TOMB OF KING DAVID; and the HOUSE OF CAIAPHAS, where Jesus was kept the night after his arrest and where Peter denied knowing him three times. (B)

DAY 7 JERUSALEM. (Sun.)

Spend a full day at leisure, with time to attend a worship service at one of Jerusalem's churches. Later, maybe join an optional excursion that includes a visit to the Israel Museum to see the Shrine of the Book and the *Dead Sea Scrolls*; the Holocaust Memorial at Yad Vashem; and the Inn of the Good Samaritan. (B,D)

DAY 8 JERUSALEM. EXCURSION TO MASADA & THE DEAD SEA. (Mon.) Today, travel through the Judean wilderness to the Dead Sea, the planet's lowest point on dry land. Enjoy the scenery as you follow the road between the salty water and majestic desert mountains. Catch glimpses of the Caves of Qumran, where the precious *Dead Sea Scrolls* were found. Ascend by CABLE CAR to the spectacular clifftop FORTRESS OF MASADA, and hear how 960 Jewish rebels made their last stand against Roman forces. Around lunchtime, reach your comfortable DEAD SEA RESORT for free time to experience the incredible buoyancy in the heavy saltwater. Return to Jerusalem, and join your travelling companions one last time at tonight's farewell dinner to celebrate the blessings you experienced on your Holy Land adventure. (B,D)

DAY 1 ARRIVE IN ROME, ITALY. (Mon.)

Welcome to Rome! At 5 pm, meet your Tour Director, then enjoy this evening's welcome dinner at a local restaurant to celebrate the start of your spiritual journey through Italy. (D)

DAY 2 ROME. EXCURSION TO CASTEL GANDOLFO. (Tue.)

Look forward to a unique experience with a guided visit to the impressive PAPAL PALACE in Castel Gandolfo. The former summer residence of the popes is now a museum that is open to the public. Also visit the magnificent BARBERINI GARDENS, where ruins of the residence of Roman Emperor Domitian are still visible. Return to Rome and discover Vatican City with a guided visit of the VATICAN MUSEUMS, a unique collection of religious and secular art that spans centuries. Explore some of the finest examples of Renaissance paintings and visit the SISTINE CHAPEL, world famous for Michelangelo's ceiling paintings and The Last Judgment, as well as the place where the conclave takes place for the election of the new popes. DAY 3 ROME. (Wed.)

This morning, attend the PAPAL AUDIENCE (subject to availability) for the chance to see the Pope and receive the Papal Blessing. Later, visit ST. PAUL OUTSIDE THE WALLS, one of Rome's four major Papal basilicas built by Constantine on the grave of St. Paul, beheaded by Nero around 65-67 AD. Explore the mysterious ancient CATACOMBS that run under the city. During the persecutions, the catacombs were used as places of

refuge for the celebration of the Eucharist. Next, visit ST. JOHN LATERAN BASILICA and the HOLY STAIRS, brought from Jerusalem to Rome around 326 AD by St. Helena, mother of Constantine the Great, Officially, pilgrims may only ascend these 28 white marble steps on their knees. Then, visit the hallowed halls of ST. MARY MAJOR BASILICA. Its beautiful treasures are of inestimable value, and represent the Church's role as the cradle of Christian artistic civilisation in Rome. For nearly sixteen centuries, St. Mary Major has held its position as a Marian shrine par excellence and has been a magnet for pilgrims from all over the world who have come to the Eternal City to experience the beauty, grandeur, and holiness of the basilica. (B)

DAY 4 ROME-CASCIA-ASSISI. (Thu.)

Depart Rome today and head north into Umbria for a stop in Cascia to explore the life of St. Rita, known as the "Saint of the Impossible." Visit the BASILICA, see the tomb with the saint's incorrupt body, and attend Mass. DAY 5 ASSISI. (Fri.)

Attend Mass this morning, followed by a guided walking tour of Assisi. Visit the BASILICAS OF ST. FRANCIS and ST. CLARE. See the crucifix that spoke to St. Francis, who abandoned a life of luxury for a life devoted to Christianity after the voice of God commanded him to rebuild the Christian church and live in poverty. He is the patron saint of animals and the environment. St. Clare was one of St. Francis' first followers and founded the Order of Poor Clares, a monastic religious order for women in the Franciscan tradition. A short trip by minibus takes you to the CARCERI HERMITAGE, a peaceful oasis in the woods of Mount Subasio where St. Francis came to pray. Finally, visit the MONASTERY OF ST. DAMIAN, a Franciscan shrine built on the spot where St. Francis heard the voice of Christ, and where he wrote the Canticle of the Creatures. The convent founded by St. Clare, where she died in 1253, is still intact. This afternoon, you may wish to join an optional excursion to magnificent medieval Spello. (B)

DAY 6 ASSISI-SIENA-FLORENCE. (Sat.)

Leave Assisi and enter Tuscany. In Siena, meet your Local Guide and learn all about St. Catherine, a saint, a mystic, a doctor of the Church, and the patroness of Italy and Europe. You'll visit the BASILICA OF ST. DOMINIC, ST. CATHERINE'S SANCTUARY, and her HOUSE. Then, enjoy a walk through the ancient narrow lanes and visit beautiful PIAZZA DEL CAMPO. Before crossing the French border, visit the Sanctuary of St. Ignatius de Loyola, founder of the Order of Jesus (Jesuits), with his HOME, and attend Mass in the BASILICA. Arrive in Lourdes, a powerful place of pilgrimage dedicated to the Holy Virgin, where you will stay for the next three nights with the possibility of joining the candlelight procession, held every evening. (B,D)

Today's Distance: 280 mi / 450 km

DAY 7 LOURDES.

This morning attend Mass. Your guided walking tour includes visits to the GROTTO, where the Virgin Mary appeared to St. Bernadette, the OUR LADY OF LOURDES SHRINE, the BIRTHPLACE OF ST. BERNADETTE, and her FAMILY HOME during the time of the apparitions. In the evening of February 11, 1858, a young Roman Catholic girl, Bernadette Soubirous, went to fetch some firewood with her sister and another companion when a Lady who was indescribably beautiful appeared to her at the Massabielle grotto. Although the Lady did not tell Bernadette her name when asked at first, she told her to return to the grotto. On subsequent visits, the Lady revealed herself to be the "Immaculate Conception." (B)

DAY 8 LOURDES.

Enjoy a day at leisure with time to experience the powerful healing baths, the "Blessing of the Sick," and attend one of the daily Masses. The whole town exudes a spiritual atmosphere that leads to prayer. You may also wish to marvel at the natural beauty of the Pyrenees on the optional excursion available. (B,D)

DAY 9 LOURDES-BARCELONA, SPAIN.

Leave Lourdes today, re-enter Spain, and head for Barcelona—the capital of Spain's Catalonia region-known for its art and architecture throughout the cosmopolitan city. (B)

Today's Distance: 348 mi / 560 km

DAY 10 BARCELONA.

Sightseeing with a Local Guide features the Columbus Monument, Plaza de Catalunia, and Paseo de Gracia. The highlight is a visit to the SAGRADA FAMILIA BASILICA, Gaudi's masterpiece. As the lead traveller, you represent and warrant that you are authorised to accept The Company's Terms & Conditions on behalf of everyone named in your booking, and you will be deemed to have accepted The Company's Terms & Conditions on behalf of everyone named in your booking.

 Payment of the deposit indicates you have read and accepted these Terms & Conditions. Your booking is not confirmed until the deposit is processed by The Company and you receive a confirmation invoice.

HOLIDAY DEPOSIT

5. Except as provided in clause 12, a non-refundable, non-transferable deposit of \$250 per person, per land tour is required for The Company to reserve space for you, with some limited exceptions as noted below. The deposit must be received within 7 days of booking. On certain departures, deposits and/or passport details may be required at time of booking to hold or to confirm space for you. Your reservation will be automatically cancelled if the deposit is not received by The Company by the deposit due date. Your booking is not confirmed and payment is not deemed made until the deposit is received by The Company and The Company sends a confirmation invoice to you. Any bookings made within 21 days of your departure from Australia will incur a late booking fee of \$30 per transaction.

HOLIDAY FINAL PAYMENT

In the case of billing errors, The Company reserves the right to re-invoice you with correct pricing.

FORM OF PAYMENT

 The Company accepts payment via Bpay, electronic fund transfer (EFT), Paypal, cheque, Visa, MasterCard and American Express. Merchant fees apply to purchases made by credit card.

SUBJECT TO CHANGE ITINERARIES

11. Holiday departures in 2021 are subject to itinerary modifications. Full details will be available in June 2020. Travellers have the right to cancel their reservation without penalty within 7 days of notification in the event of itinerary modifications for departures in 2021 prior to the release of the 2021 brochure.

BOOKING CANCELLATIONS & CANCELLATION FEES

- 12. Subject to clause 13 below, you have a cooling-off period of seven (7) days during which you may cancel your holiday. Your cancellation must be made in writing and received by The Company within the cooling-off period. The cooling-off period will commence on the first day following the day on which you book your holiday. If you cancel your holiday during the cooling-off period your deposit will be refunded and no cancellation fee will apply. If you do not cancel your holiday during the cooling-off period, then all other Terms and Conditions apply.
- 13. No cooling-off period will apply to holidays booked less than 45 days before a scheduled land tour departure, and less than 90 days before a scheduled cruise departure, or earlier if specified for the particular holiday. For bookings made within these periods, payment in full is required at the time of booking.

20. Cancellation fees relating to insurance policies will be subject to the terms and conditions of the insurance provider's policy and will incur the standard Revision Fee (see "Revision Fees" below)

TERMS & CONDITIONS CONTINUED

21. Cancellation fees may also apply to any additional services, including extra night accommodations, independently supplied services, and optional excursions reserved prior to, during, and after the tour. If flight changes, including but not limited to flight cancellations or name changes, are requested after full cruise and air deposits are received, revision fees, change fees, or airline cancellation fees will apply (see "Revision Fees" below). In many instances, airline revision or change fees can be up to \$300, but in some instances may be up to 100% of the ticket price. Cancellation penalties will be guided at time of cancellation.

- Travellers who are under 18 years old on the departure date must be accompanied by an adult throughout the holiday and are requested to share an adult's accommodation.

- 28. The Company is not responsible for any disputes between roommates (such as sleep patterns, snoring, noise, etc.). Any dispute between roommates is your responsibility to resolve. During the holiday, alternate single arrangements, if available, may be secured but are never guaranteed. You are responsible for all expenses for any change in accommodation on tour and payment in full will be required immediately upon securing new accommodations.

29. All shares are non-smoking.

AIR ARRANGEMENTS

- 30. If airfares have been purchased through The Company, please note that all carriers are independent operators and are not owned, managed, or operated by The Company. Your airline ticket is a contract between you and the air carrier only, even if you purchase through The Company. By purchasing your air services through The Company, you waive all liability for The Company for such air services.
- 31. The Company is not responsible if an airline cancels, reschedules, or delays a flight for any reason. If you purchased air through The Company, we will try to assist in making new arrangements, providing you have not already checked in with your airline for your first flight segment. After check-in, you must work with the airline directly to reach your destination or to make any alternate arrangements, including amendments to return services. Airline fees often apply for modifications to air schedules not related to airline-imposed flight cancellations, reschedules, or delays. These fees will be payable to the airline directly at time of request.
- 32. If you miss your departure flight or connection, it is your responsibility to work with the airline on which you are ticketed to reach your destination. No refunds will be provided by The Company for portions of trips missed due to cancelled, rescheduled, or delayed flights after airport check-in, nor is The Company responsible for any additional expenses you may incur prior to joining your trip if you miss your departure flight or flight connection.
- 33. For air purchased through The Company, if any air schedule requires an overnight stay in a gateway city, The Company can assist you with hotel reservations; however, the cost of the overnight stay (including but not limited to hotel and meals) is your expense. Air routings are subject to availability. Routings are not guaranteed and are subject to change at any time.
- 34. If you make your own flight arrangements,
 The Company will not be responsible for any
 loss resulting from cancellation or changes in
 international gateways, itineraries, or travel dates.
 We recommend that you do not purchase airline
 tickets with high penalty charges for changes.

AIR-INCLUSIVE HOLIDAYS & FINAL PAYMENT

35. Additional deposits or payments are required for international air added to the start and/or end of your holiday and/or for intra-holiday air, as specified in the itinerary ("air-inclusive holidays"). Air-inclusive holiday pricing is guaranteed upon receipt of tour deposit plus full airfare payment, subject to airline conditions.

AUTHORITY TO REMOVE OR REFUSE PASSENGERS

36. In the sole discretion of The Company, The Company may refuse transport to any passenger or may require any passenger to leave the tour if it is reasonably believed that the passenger (1) is dangerous to others or to himself or herself; (2) has engaged in, is engaged in, or is threatening to engage in behaviour that may adversely affect the safety, security, comfort, enjoyment, or well-being of other passengers or The Company's representatives, including, but not limited to, behaviour that is disruptive, verbally abusive, physically abusive, obnoxious, harassing, discriminatory, or obscene;

or (3) has failed or refused or is failing or refusing to following The Company rules and procedures or the instructions of The Company, its representatives, or the crew members. In the event a passenger is removed, such passenger may be left at any city without any liability to The Company or its representatives. The Company shall not be required to refund any portion of the fare paid by any passenger who is removed under the terms of this paragraph, nor shall The Company be responsible for expenses for lodging, medical care, meals, transportation, or any other expenses incurred by the passenger. The Company shall be entitled to recover from the passenger any costs or expenses incurred by The Company, its representatives, or the crew members in the removal of the passenger or the exercise or enforcement of this clause.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE & LIABILITY

- 37. Porterage at hotels for one suitcase per person is included in the holiday price (where available). Airport/train station porterage is not included, unless otherwise specified in your Travel Documents. Be prepared to carry your own suitcase on and off airplanes and trains and through airports and train stations. We regret that we are unable to accept a second suitcase or any luggage exceeding these limits on any holiday offered by The Company. Some holidays have more restrictive regulations than those listed above. Refer to your Travel Documents for more information.
- 39. Air carrier restrictions may vary from the limitations listed above. Size and weight limitations for carry-on and checked baggage vary from airline to airline and even according to destination. While making an airinclusive booking, you will be provided with baggage fee information. After booking an air-inclusive booking, up-to-date information on carrier-specific standard checked baggage allowance (including size and weight limitations), the standard allowance (and fee, if applicable) for carry-on baggage, and the standard fee for the first and second checked bag, along with the information about additional discounts that may apply depending on flyer-specific factors (e.g., frequent flyer status, military, credit card used for purchase, or early purchase over the Internet, etc.) can be found on the carrier's website or by accessing iflybags.com. The Company is not responsible for additional fees imposed by air carriers for baggage, and these fees are not included in the air-inclusive holiday price. - 43. Some local and foreign government agencies require The Company to collect and pass on in advance of travel certain personal and other details related to you, including but not limited to government-issued identification and passport details. If you fail to supply the details, as requested, fully and accurately, your trip may be interrupted or cancelled. There are no refunds for failure to provide documentation or failure to provide documentation by the time required.
- 44. We will use your personal data secured during your booking or during online check-in to process your booking with our suppliers. These details include your full name, address, date of birth, passport number and expiration date, occupation, credit/ debit card information, and any disability, medical conditions, or dietary restrictions disclosed to The Company for you and all in your travelling party.
- 45. It may be necessary to transfer these details to other countries or authorities whose data protection and privacy laws may be different than ours. This may include requirements to pass details to our suppliers as well as certain governments or government-appointed bodies or agencies in the interest of security or because we are obliged to by law. By making a booking with The Company, you agree to The Company storing, using, and passing on this data to other third parties for reasons as stated above, and hold The Company not liable for the usage and protection of that data.

EMERGENCY CONTACT DETAILS

46. All passengers must provide emergency contact details, travel insurance information and passport or government issued ID information (when required) PRIOR TO TRAVEL. 47. All Tour Directors, Local Hosts®, Local Guides, and ships' crews speak English, and all holiday commentary and instruction are conducted in English only. For maximum enjoyment and understanding, you should be able to read, understand, and speak English.

FORCE MAJEURE

48. The Company assumes no liability for any loss. damage, or entry of any nature in whole or in part resulting from an Act of God or any other force majeure condition, including without limitation: fire, volcanic eruption, environmental pollution or contamination, inclement weather, earthquake, low or high water levels, flood, water or power shortages or failures, tropical storms or hurricanes, riots or civil commissions or disturbances, and any other acts of a similar nature, sabotage, arrests. strikes or labour disruptions, restraint of rulers or peoples, expropriations, acts of terrorism, war, insurrection, quarantine restrictions, government health advisories or warnings or alerts of any kind of nature, government seizures, refusal or cancellation or suspension or delay of any government authority or any license, permit or authorisation, damages to its facilities or the travel supplier and its facilities, or any other unforeseen circumstances or any other factors unforeseen by The Company that impacts negatively on, or hampers, its ability to fulfil any of its contractual conditions. Please note that included gratuities for The Company cover wait staff at included meals. hospitality staff at hotels for nights purchased through The Company, porterage at hotels for one suitcase per person, the cruise director, crew, local guides and local drivers and the cruise portion only; prepaid gratuities cover only the land portion operated by The Company of the tour itinerary. Where The Company sources other leading operators for cruising or rail elements of your holiday, the option to prepay local gratuities is not

Any medical attention you require while travelling with The Company must be sought through a local medical facility, if/ when available, for diagnosis. All related charges are at your expense.
- 64. The Company reserves the right to remove or quarantine any passenger who shows signs of illness, or who poses a threat to the safety and health of other passengers. Removal or quarantine of passengers for any health, safety, or behaviour-related assessment is at the sole discretion of The Company. Any costs incurred for medical assessments, diagnosis and/or any other medically-related charges are your responsibility to pay and are due at time of services. Passengers will be allowed to rejoin The Company's tour with confirmed medical certification from a licensed health practitioner indicating fit to travel without causing harm or posing a safety threat to other passengers.

MOTORCOACHES

Any advice or assistance on or with any Service provided by any local representative does not mean or imply that the Service is sold, supervised, or controlled by The Company, or that any such advice or assistance is given on behalf of The Company. Holiday participants are asked to check with the operator of any optional shore excursion and the applicable Terms & Conditions before booking.
- 70. For operational reasons, not all optional excursions listed in the itinerary, in print, online, or in Travel Documents may be available during your holiday. Your Tour Director will advise of availability while on the tour.

Holiday prices are per person, based on double occupancy (two people sharing a room). Single room supplements and triple reductions are listed where applicable. REFUNDS

78. For Private Touring, changes made at your discretion en route to tour features or tour services (e.g. meals, included sightseeing, etc..) are not refundable nor exchangeable for other services. 84. After returning from your holiday, if you wish to enquire about any services provided, please ensure that all correspondence relating to those services is received by The Company, Client Relations, Circuit Travel Pty Ltd. Any complaint or claim involving the holiday services offered in the Globus or Cosmos brochure or on the Globus or Cosmos website involving the negligence of any suppliers, sub-

contractors, or agents in relation to any service provided to the holiday participant must be notified to Tour/Cruise Director immediately while on holiday or within 30 days of the holiday completion, except where such time limitations are prohibited by law.

SMOKING & ILLEGAL DRUGS

TOUR CANCELLATIONS

89. The Company reserves the right to cancel or reschedule any holiday departure for any reason, including insufficient demand or force majeure (see section 48 above). If a holiday is cancelled prior to departure, The Company's only responsibility will be to refund the amount received for the reservation. The Company will try to rebook the same holiday with a different departure date, or a similar holiday, but there is no quarantee of availability of offering. For air-inclusive holidays, The Company will try to confirm air schedules for the selected new dates, subject to availability. The Company cannot assume responsibility for any additional costs or any fees relating to the issuance and/or cancellation of air tickets or other travel arrangements not made through The Company.

TRANSFERS

90. Unless otherwise specified, transfers arranged by The Company are provided by independent transportation suppliers and are group transfers operated by motorcoach and may have pre-set departures times. The Company is not responsible for flight delays, delays in immigration or customs, delays due to lost baggage, or delays for any reason beyond our control if you miss your transfer. Missed transfers are non-refundable.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

91. Travel Documents, including e-ticket itineraries, are available approximately four weeks prior to departure provided full payment, emergency contact details, travel insurance information and passport information have been received, and passengers have acknowledged the Globus family of brands Terms and Conditions, via their customer MyAccount. A service charge will be applied where multiple copies of documentation are requested. Alternatively, e-documentation may be issued.

TRAVELLING WITH CHILDREN

92. Due to heightened security, many countries have adopted practices to prevent international abductions of children. You are responsible for obtaining independently and paying for all visas and entry documents, for meeting all health and other requirements, and for any documents required by the laws, regulations, orders, and/or requirements of the countries you will visit. The Company cannot accept liability for any passenger refused entry on any transport or into any country due to failure of the passenger to carry correct documentation or adhere to specific entry and exit requirements.
- 100. You must have a passport to travel internationally. Most countries require that the passport be valid for at least six (6) months beyond the conclusion of your trip. It is recommended you have a minimum of three blank pages in your passport when travelling. Multiple-entry visas are required for some holidays. The process of obtaining a visa and/or passport can take up to three months or more.

101. During the course of your cruise, tour, or excursion, you may encounter the opportunity to participate in additional, optional activities that are provided by independent third-party suppliers. The suppliers of those optional services may render those services subject to separate and additional terms and conditions, or may require you to execute additional documents, waivers, or releases. It is understood that any assumptions of liability, waivers, or releases that are part of the suppliers' terms and conditions or that are required by those independent suppliers will also inure to the benefit of Circuit Travel Pty Ltd, Avalon Waterways, Globus, Cosmos and Monograms.

102. Wi-Fi connectivity is not always guaranteed, and is often may be disrupted, unavailable, and slower on board than you are accustomed.

103.
