

Catholic heritage in Italy extends well beyond the Vatican. Discover the inspiring Catholic Italian icons of northern Italy. From Milan's St. Ambrose to Turin's St. John Bosco and Padua's St. Anthony, you'll collect memories and inspiration that will remain with you for life. Admire in awe the early Christian works of art of the Byzantine era in Ravenna, and spend two full days in Rome, focusing on the Papal legacies. Visit many inspiring places of worship that instill a sense of solemnity and serenity.



Day 1. ARRIVE IN MILAN, ITALY. Check into your the industrial revolution. Your visit includes hotel and, if you have time, start exploring this busy city on your own before meeting your tour companions and Tour Director during the included on St John Bosco's rooms, currently under welcome dinner at your hotel. (D)

Day 2. MILAN. Dedicate the morning to Milan's most important Catholic churches: ST AMBROSE BASILICA and the DUOMO. St Ambrose is the patron saint of bee keepers beggars, learners and Milan. Celebrate Mass and admire the treasures of the Basilica and the Duomo with a Local Guide. (B)

Day 3. MILAN-TURIN. Turin is known in the Catholic community worldwide as the home of the Holy Shroud, only available to the public on very special occasions. The city was also home to St. John Bosco, the priest who founded the Salesian religious institute to help poor children with their education during

the HOLY SHROUD MUSEUM, the BASILICA OF ST. MARY AUSILIATRICE, and a video renovation. You'll have time to appreciate the elegance of this city and former capital of Italy before attending 🛤 Mass. (B) Today's Distance: 90 mi / 145 km

Day 4. TURIN-PAVIA-SIRMIONE-PADUA.

Pavia is home to a beautiful CARTHUSIAN MONASTERY, built in the 1400s by Gian Galeazzo Visconti, Duke of Milan. The monastery is one of Italy's "hidden treasures" with lavish decorations and monks who still live a traditional life of seclusion and prayer. On the way to Padua, you'll also stop in Sirmione, a charming village on Lake Garda. Its medieval peninsula is protected by walls and a bridge connecting it to the mainland. (B,D) Today's Distance: 245 mi / 395 km

morning 😝 Mass and visit ST. ANTHONY BASILICA in Padua with a local

guide, then enjoy a short city sightseeing and time on your own. In the afternoon, on the way to Ravenna, we'll stop to see the ABBEY OF POMPOSA, where the Benedictine monk Guido d'Arezzo invented modern musical notation in the 11th century. (B,D) Todav's Distance: 85 mi / 137 km

Day 6. RAVENNA-ROME. UNESCO declared the early Christian monuments of Ravenna as having "outstanding universal value." Ravenna was the seat of the Roman Empire in the 5th century and of Byzantine Italy until the 8th century. It has a unique collection of early Christian mosaics and monuments. All buildings—the NEONIAN BAPTISTRY, the BASILICA OF SANT'APOLLINARE NUOVO. the CHURCH OF SAN VITALE, and the ARCHBISHOP'S CHAPEL OF ST. ANDREWwere constructed in the 5th and 6th centuries. They show great artistic skill, including a wonderful blend of Greek-Roman tradition, Christian iconography, and oriental and Western styles. The morning is dedicated to discovering these masterpieces and focusing on the Byzantine-style mosaics with a local guide. In the afternoon, travel to Rome. (B,D) Today's Distance: 221 mi / 355 km

Day 7. ROME. Today you have the unique chance to attend the PAPAL AUDIENCE in the Vatican (subject to availability). Afterwards, enjoy an included city tour with a local guide to see the BASILICA OF ST. PAUL OUTSIDE THE WALLS, where St. Paul was buried after his martyrdom,

Day 5. PADUA-POMPOSA-RAVENNA. Attend ST. JOHN LATERAN BASILICA, the Cathedral of Rome and the seat of its Bishop (the Pope) and the HOLY STAIRS. Said to have led Jesus to the praetorium of Pontius Plate, the stairs were transferred to Rome by Empress St Helena. Finally, visit ST. MARY MAJOR BASILICA, where a reliquary contains wood from the Holy Crib. Attend Mass here before returning to your hotel. (B)

> Day 8. ROME. Visit the PAPAL SUMMER RESIDENCE in Castel Gandolfo. Wander through its GARDENS, an opportunity to reflect and meditate in quiet and relaxing surroundings. Walk through the rooms where many Popes have spent the summer months enjoying the cooler countryside on the hills outside Rome. Later, you can join the optional excursion that will take you back to St. Peter's to discover the treasures of the Vatican museums, or you can spend time at leisure enjoying the many monuments of ancient Roman heritage. (B)

LOREIO

Day 1. ARRIVE IN ROME, ITALY. Welcome to Italy! Check into your hotel, with rest of the day free to explore on your own. This afternoon, meet your Tour Director and fellow travellers, and prepare for your upcoming spiritual journey. Later this evening, a welcome dinner awaits at your hotel. (D)

Day 2. ROME. This morning, attend the PAPAL AUDIENCE (subject to availability) for the chance to see the Pope and receive the Papal Blessing. Later, with a Local Guide visit ST. PAUL OUTSIDE THE WALLS, burial place of St. Paul the Apostle and one of Rome's four major Papal basilicas, along with ST. JOHN LATERAN BASILICA. Next, visit the SCALA SANCTA (Holy Stairs), transported from Jerusalem to Rome around 326 AD by St. Helena, Emperor Constantine's mother. These 28 marble steps are traditionally ascended in a kneeling position with a prayer recital dedicated to Jesus Christ. Then, visit the impressive ST. MARY MAJOR BASILICA and attend Mass. (B)

Day 3, ROME, EXCURSION TO CASTEL **GANDOLFO.** A different, quite unique experience is offered today. We will take an included excursion to Castel Gandolfo, a quaint village in the hills outside Rome. to visit the PAPAL SUMMER RESIDENCE and GARDENS with a Local Guide. Visit the rooms that have been occupied by many Popes over the centuries and enjoy the opportunity to reflect and meditate in quiet and relaxing surroundings. In the afternoon, enjoy time at leisure in Rome or join the optional excursion to the Vatican Museums and Sistine Chapel, world famous for Michelangelo's impressive fresco of The Last Judgment. (B)

Today's Distance: 50 mi / 80 km

Day 4. ROME-PIETRELCINA-SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO. Before leaving the capital city of Italy, step back in time with the help of a Local Guide and experience the power and beauty of Imperial Rome on the included orientation. On your way south, stop in quaint Pietrelcina, to visit the HOUSE where the beloved St.

Pio was born, before heading towards San Giovanni Rotondo on the east coast, the Saint's home from 1916 until his death in 1968. (B,D)

ST. JOHN LATERAN BASILICA, ROME

Today's Distance: 258 mi / 415 km

Day 5. SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO. EXCURSION TO MONTE SANT'ANGELO.

Attend Mass this morning at SANTA MARIA DELLE GRAZIE (Old Church), then visit the FRIARY of Padre Pio, including his tomb, cell, confessional, and the PADRE PIO PILGRIMAGE CHURCH (New Church). Afterwards, take a short drive to the nearby SHRINE OF MONTE SANT'ANGELO, one of Christendom's most celebrated shrines, where St. Michael the Archangel appeared in 490, 492, and 1656. (B,D)

Today's Distance: 43 mi / 70 km

Day 6. SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO-LANCIANO-LORETO-ASSISI AREA. Visit ST. FRANCIS' church in Lanciano, home of the Sanctuary of the Eucharistic Miracle, and attend morning

Mass. Continue to the SANCTUARY OF LORETO, including the HOLY HOUSE, where, according to tradition, angels transported the home of the blessed Virgin Mary. Arrive at the hilltop village of Assisi, home of St. Francis and St. Clare. (B,D)

Day 7. ASSISI. Today, learn more about St. Francis, patron saint of animals and the environment. Attend early morning A Mass at ST. FRANCIS BASILICA, famous for its 14th-century Giotto paintings depicting the

life of St. Francis. Meet your Local Guide and visit the UPPER and LOWER BASILICAS of St. Francis and the BASILICA OF ST. CLARE, founder of the Order of Poor Clares. Next, visit the BASILICA of Santa Maria degli Angeli, situated at the foot of Assisi's hills and protecting the *Porziuncola*, where St. Francis is said to have founded the Order of Friars Minor in 1209, and the *Cappella del Transito*, where the saint died in 1226. (B)

Day 8. ASSISI AREA-CASCIA-ROME. Travel to Cascia this morning, situated in Umbria and home of St. Rita, the "Patron Saint of Impossible Causes." Visit the SANCTUARY and see the Major Basilica, the chapel that houses the tomb of St. Rita. Also, see the Minor Basilica, home of the Eucharistic Miracle that is commemorated each year with the Feast of Corpus Christi. Return to Rome for a final overnight stay. (B) Today's Distance: 149 mi / 240 km

Day 9. ROME. Your holiday ends with breakfast this morning. (B)

Day 3. MILAN-TURIN. Turin is known in the Catholic community worldwide as the home of the Holy Shroud, only available to the public on very special occasions, and St. John Bosco, the priest who founded the Salesian religious institute. Your visit includes the HOLY SHROUD MUSEUM, the BASILICA OF ST. MARY AUSILIATRICE, and the CAMERETTE DI DON BOSCO. You'll have time to appreciate the elegance of this city and former capital of Italy before attending 🞮 Mass. (B) Today's Distance: 90 mi / 145 km

Day 4. TURIN-PAVIA-SIRMIONE-PADUA.

Pavia is home to a beautiful CARTHUSIAN MONASTERY, built in the 1400s by Gian Galeazzo Visconti, Duke of Milan. The monastery is one of Italy's "hidden treasures" with lavish decorations and monks who still live a traditional life of seclusion and prayer. On the way to Padua, you'll also stop in Sirmione, a charming village on Lake Garda, with a medieval peninsula protected by walls and a bridge connecting it to the mainland. (B,D) Today's Distance: 245 mi / 395 km

Day 5. PADUA-POMPOSA-RAVENNA. Attend morning Mass at ST. ANTHONY BASILICA in Padua and enjoy a visit with a local guide, followed by a short city sightseeing and time on your own. ANDREW—were constructed in the 5th and 6th centuries. They show great artistic skill, including a wonderful blend of Greek-Roman tradition, Christian iconography, and oriental and Western styles. The morning is dedicated to discovering these masterpieces and focusing on the Byzantinestyle mosaics with a local guide. In the afternoon, travel to Rome. (B,D) Today's Distance: 221 mi / 355 km

Day 7. ROME. Today you have the unique chance to attend the PAPAL AUDIENCE in the Vatican (subject to availability). Afterwards, eniov an included city tour with a local guide to see the BASILICA OF ST. PAUL OUTSIDE Cathedral of Rome and the seat of its Bishop (the Pope) famous for the Holy Stairs. 

Day 9, Sat. LOURDES-CARCASSONNE-MONTSERRAT, SPAIN. Head for the France/ Spain border, Stop to visit the FORTIFIED CITADEL of Carcassonne, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. 

You will also pass through the village of Ferreiros. On arrival in Portomarin, relax at one of the many outdoor cafes in the main square. (B.D)

Day 4. Wed. PORTOMARIN-LESTEDO (approx. 20 km/12.5 mi - avg 4.5 hrs difficulty 2/3). Let your mind wander and the feet follow. Begin the day by crossing over the Belesar dam footbridge, then start a gradual climb to the village of Ligonde. This stage mainly runs along and anderos (paths) next to the road or, in some cases, along paved trails. There are many signs indicating the pilgrim route, including the famous cruceiros (crucifixes). Check out the Cruceiro of Lameiros and the Monastery of Our Saviour of Vilar de Donas (2 km/1.2 mi detour off the Camino). Overnight in Lestedo. (B,D)

Day 5, Thu. LESTEDO-MELIDE (approx. 18 km/ 11.2 mi - avg 4 hrs - difficulty 2/3). Keep an open mind and heart, let go of expectations, and enjoy the feeling of freedom along this ancient

pilgrim path. The Camino takes you into the province of Coruña, with its fine eucalyptus and pine expanses, and numerous medieval bridges, such as the ones in Leboreiro and Furelos. Melide is an obligatory stop for food lovers; the best known local delicacy here is octopus. (B,D)

Begin by driving to the old port of JAFFA, an atmospheric town, where Jonah set sail before he was swallowed by the whale. Continue to CAESAREA, an ancient port turned incredible ARCHAEOLOGICAL ZONE. Built by Herod the Great in the 1st century BC, the city was one of the most splendid in ancient Palestine and its capital for more than 600 years. Admire what remains of Herod's grandiose building works, including the restored 3,500seat Roman theatre, the aqueduct, harbour, and the crumbled moat and towers from the 12th-century CRUSADER FORTRESS. From here, travel to the archaeological site of MEGIDDO, an age-old FORTIFIED TOWN with 25 layers of archaeological findings and one of the world's most important biblical sites. According to the New Testament, this is where the Battle of Armageddon will take place, the final struggle between good and evil, which will prompt the return of Jesus to defeat the Antichrist and cast Satan into the abyss.

THE ANNUNCIATION, where the Archangel Gabriel told Mary she would conceive and give birth to Jesus, the Son of God. This evening you may have an opportunity to join a candlelight procession starting from the Church of the Annunciation square. (B,D) Today's Distance: 121 mi / 195 km

Day 3, Sun. NAZARETH. EXCURSION TO BET SHE'AN. Attend one of the early morning Mass services if you wish, then join today's included excursion. Bet She'an is one of the best preserved archaeological sites of this region and well worth some time to wander around. Ongoing excavations at this UNESCO World Heritage site revealed time-worn colonnadestyle streets, bathhouses, and a theatre with perfect acoustics. (B)

Day 4, Mon. NAZARETH. EXCURSION TO MAGDALA-SEA OF GALILEE-TABGHA-CAPERNAUM-MOUNT OF BEATITUDES-

CANA. Today, celebrate Mass in Magdala, home to Mary Magdalene, then skirt the Sea of Galilee, and enjoy its scenic beauty. Continue to Tabgha and visit the church commemorating the miracle of Jesus feeding 5,000 people with two fish and five loaves. On to CAPERNAUM, home to the Apostles Peter, Andrew, James, John, and Matthew,

Day 5, Tue. NAZARETH-BETHLEHEM-JERUSALEM. Enjoy a spectacular drive through the Jordan Valley. Stop at the QASR EL YAHUD baptismal site where, according to tradition, Jesus was baptised by St. John the Baptist. Continue to Bethlehem, birthplace of Jesus and King David. Visit one of Christianity's holiest places, the CHURCH OF THE NATIVITY, built over the cave thought to be the spot where Jesus was born. Here, you will have time to pray and attend Mass, if you like. 


